Easter is a holiday and as with our American culture, we celebrate holidays with gatherings and food, smiles and connections. But what happens after? What about Monday? What did the ladies do the next day after they saw Jesus? What are we supposed to do next? Well, stores will tell you it is time to celebrate Mother's Day, Memorial Day, Earth Day, April Fools Day, Election Day... Christmas! Ok, maybe not Christmas. But we just go from one celebration to the next, encouraged to buy more to celebrate. But is that what Easter is, just another holiday?

We have been watching "The Chosen" throughout Lent and the last one we watched was season two, episode two called "I Saw You." In the episode, Phillip shares that the old is gone, the past is not who we are today. He was talking to Matthew as he was always outcast as a tax collector. Phillip was explaining that he was no longer a tax collector and Simon was no longer a fisherman, but they are followers of Christ, Disciples (although he did not use that word). Are the disciples known as what they did before, or what they do as followers of Christ? Are we known by life before Easter? Are we stuck in thinking of ourselves as our past, what we used to be, who we once were? That is what it means to be an Easter people, that is what is next...living as a worthwhile follower and letting go of the sinner label we have been carrying for far too long. Embrace Easter, Embrace Forgiveness.





#### **MORAVIAN WOMEN**


